The maximum you can surcharge any fare by 25%.

006. IF ANY SURCHARGE IS MORE THAN 25%, IN THAT CASE, WHAT YOU HAVE TO DO?

If any surcharge is for more than 25%, in that case, you have to "Break The Journey."

007. WHAT IS THE FORMULA TO FIND OUT THE PERCENTAGE (%) OF THE SURCHARGE?

The formula to find out the percentage of the surcharge is:- Divide the TPM total by the MPM

008. WHAT WILL YOU DO, IF THE RESULT IS OVER 1.00000 BUT NOT HIGHER THAN 1.05?

Surcharge the fare by: 5%

009. WHAT WILL YOU DO, IF THE RESULT IS OVER 1.05000 BUT NOT HIGHER THAN 1.10?

Surcharge the fare by: 10%

010.	WHAT WILL YOU DO, IF THE RESULT IS OVER 1.10000 BUT NOT HIGHER THAN 1.15?
#	Surcharge the fare by: 15%
011.	WHAT WILL YOU DO, IF THE RESULT IS OVER 1.15000 BUT NOT HIGHER THAN 1.20?
#	Surcharge the fare by: 20%
012.	WHAT WILL YOU DO, IF THE RESULT IS OVER 1.20000 BUT NOT HIGHER THAN 1.25?
#	Surcharge the fare by: 25%
013.	WHAT WILL YOU DO, IF THE RESULT IS OVER 1.25000?
#	Break the journey
014.	WHEN USING THE "EMS" FORMULA, IN THE CALCULATOR AFTER THE DECIMAL HOW MANY FIGURE YOU HAVE TO CONSIDER?
#	When using this formula always check up to five decimal places in the calculator.

Itinerary: Budapest (Code - BUD / State - X-----X / Country - Hungary / Continent - Europe / Sub Groups - X-----X / Region - X-----X / Sub Area - Europe / Area - 2) - MA - Tunis (Code - TUN / State - X-----X / Country - Tunisia / Continent - Africa / Sub Groups - X-----X / Region - X-----X / Sub Area - Europe / Area - 2) - TN - Cairo (Code - CAI / State - X-----X / Country - Egypt / Continent - Africa / Sub Groups - X-----X / Region - X-----X / Sub Area - Middle East / Area - 2) - MS - Dubai (Code - DXB / State - X-----X / Country - United Arab Emirates / Continent - Asia / Sub Groups - X-----X / Region - X-----X / Sub Area - Middle East / Area - 2)

TPM is higher than MPM

After giving the EMA of 100 miles, still the TPM (3354) is higher than MPM (3024). In that case we will find out the % of the surcharge by dividing the TPM with MPM

HOW TO ENTER IN FARE LADDER

023. IN "MANUAL TICKET ENTRY," WHERE WE HAVE TO WRITE DOWN "M" CODE AND WHAT DOES IT INDICATES?

Enter the code "M" (with the percentage of surcharge if any) on the space above the fare indicates the Excess Mileage Surcharge if any.

HOW TO ENTER IN AUTOMATED TICKET ENTRY

024. IN "AUTOMATED TICKET ENTRY," WHERE WE HAVE TO WRITE DOWN "M" CODE?

The code "M" (with the percentage of surcharge if any) is entered after the destination point and before fare.

EXAMPLE:
