001. WHAT INFORMATION WE GENERALLY GET FROM "MAXIMUM PERMITTED MILEAGE (MPM)"?

The maximum distance in air miles that the passenger is allowed to travel between the origin and destination of a fare component.

002. WHAT DO YOU MEAN BY "SHORTEST OPERATED MILEAGE (SOM)"?

Maximum distance usually based on 120% of the Shortest Operated Mileage (SOM) between the points concerned.

003. FROM WHERE WE CAN FIND PUBLISHED "MPM"?

You can find published MPM in either:-

PAT (Passenger Air Tariff) fares books

Maximum Permitted Mileages book

Fares pages under "GI / MPM & Routing" column

004. HOW WE HAVE TO DETERMINE THE "MPM" FOR ANY ITINERARY?

Establish the global indicator for the routing traveled between the fare component origin and the fare component destination
